

## Feng Chia University International Student Admission FAQ

Q1: I have submitted the online application form and uploaded all the required documents; does it mean that I have finished the application procedure?

A1: Yes. You will receive an email notification to inform you we had received your application if you had handed in all the required documents, or you will receive an email for resubmit the documents.

Q2: I have only one copy of the original transcript, can I send a photocopy to you instead?

A2: Please send us the transcripts that are issued by your university. Usually students can apply for more transcripts or have the photocopies stamped in such office as the registration office at the school.

Q3: What is the Study plan? Is there any guideline offered?

A3: You have to state your motives and plans for study at FCU in the statement of Purpose, which is printed on a separate piece of paper, either in Chinese or in English. Length is not limited, and there is no guideline offered.

Q4: What is the status of my application?

A4: To check the status of your application, you will need to sign into your Application for Admission using your email address and date of birth. Go to the "inquire online" section and check for the status of your applications.

Q5: How many programs can I apply for?

A5: Most applicants can submit **TWO** applications for different programs.

Q6: Is there any requirement of English proficiency test?

A6: It varies from program to program. Even if the program you intend to apply doesn't require proof of English proficiency, we still recommend you attach it. Similarly, you can also attach your Chinese proficiency test report (please send the original copy) even if it is not required. To check whether Language Proficiency Certificate is required or not, please refer to the additional requirements.

Q7: How do I prepare the financial statement when my major financial support will actually be the scholarships I am applying for at the same time?

A7: If your major financial support is the scholarships, and you can't submit other

financial statement, then you don't have to submit the financial statement. However, if the admission result is influenced by not submitting the financial statement, it is applicant's own responsibility.

Q8: I am a Taiwan Scholarship winner. I would like to know if providing a letter from Ministry of Foreign Affairs would be sufficient as a bank statement.

A8: Yes.

Q9: Regarding the tuition fee, do I have to pay for one semester or two semesters at a time?

A9: Students pay their tuition fee at the beginning of every semester. So you pay for a semester at a time.

Q10: Are there any scholarships or financial aids foreign applicants are eligible to apply for?

A10: The scholarships and financial aids are as follow:

- a. **FCU International Student Scholarship/Financial Aid.** Full tuition fee scholarship/financial aid and half tuition fee scholarship/financial aid.

Q11: What qualifications do I need to apply for the New International Student Scholarship?

A11: Recipients of international students, Students who have not received the Taiwan Scholarship may apply for this scholarship/financial aid.

Q12: What should I prepare for the application?

A12: Applicants don't need to prepare additional documents. The committee members will evaluate your qualification along with your admission. However, applicants should prepare:

- a. **Applicants who are applying for an English-language program should submit a certificate of English proficiency, such as a TOEFL, IELTS, or TOEIC certificate.**
- b. **Applicants who apply for a Chinese-language program should submit a certificate of Chinese proficiency, such as a TOCFL certificate.**

Q13: How do I find out if I am eligible for scholarships?

A13: The awarded list will be posted on the admissions website according to the announced date in the admission handbook. Also, the applicants will be notice along with the admission notification. To find out if you are eligible for an award you will need to search for scholarships on the admissions website.

Q14: When will I receive the scholarship?

A14: Scholarships/financial aid, for the full amount of tuition and miscellaneous expenses or half the amount of tuition and miscellaneous expenses, are issued in two installments, one per semester. Scholarship funds are deposited directly into recipient bank accounts in March and October.

Q15: How can I continue receiving the scholarship?

A15: Applications for a continuation of financial aid shall be submitted to the Office of International Affairs before the announced deadline.

Q16: If I do not receive any scholarships and financial aids in this academic year, can I apply in the next academic year?

A16: Yes, students who enrolled in undergraduate programs and have earned an average score of sixty-five or higher in courses during the previous academic year and a ranking in the top sixty percent of their class, as well as a conduct score of eighty or higher may apply for scholarships and financial aids  
Students who enrolled in Master's or doctoral degree programs and have earned an average score of seventy-five or higher in courses and a conduct score of eighty or higher during the previous academic year may apply for scholarships and financial aids
