

Scholarships and Financial Aids FAQ

Q1: Are there any scholarships or financial aids foreign applicants are eligible to apply for?

A1: The scholarships and financial aids are as follow:

- a. **FCU International Student Scholarship/Financial Aid.** Full tuition fee scholarship/financial aid and half tuition fee scholarship/financial aid.

Q2: What qualifications do I need to apply for the New International Student Scholarship?

A2: Recipients of international students, Students who have not received the Taiwan Scholarship may apply for this scholarship/financial aid.

Q3: What should I prepare for the application?

A3: Applicants don't need to prepare additional documents. The committee members will evaluate your qualification along with your admission. However, applicants should prepare:

- a. **Applicants who are applying for an English-language program should submit a certificate of English proficiency, such as a TOEFL, IELTS, or TOEIC certificate.**
- b. **Applicants who apply for a Chinese-language program should submit a certificate of Chinese proficiency, such as a TOCFL certificate.**

Q4: How do I find out if I am eligible for scholarships?

A4: The awarded list will be posted on the admissions website according to the announced date in the admission handbook. Also, the applicants will be notice along with the admission notification. To find out if you are eligible for an award you will need to search for scholarships on the admissions website.

Q5: When will I receive the scholarship?

A5: Scholarships/financial aid, for the full amount of tuition and miscellaneous expenses or half the amount of tuition and miscellaneous expenses, are issued in two installments, one per semester. Scholarship funds are deposited directly into recipient bank accounts in March and October.

Q6: How can I continue receiving the scholarship?

A6: Applications for a continuation of financial aid shall be submitted to the Office of International

Affairs before the announced deadline.

Q7: If I do not receive any scholarships and financial aids in this academic year, can I apply in the next academic year?

A7: Yes, students who enrolled in undergraduate programs and have earned an average score of sixty-five or higher in courses during the previous academic year and a ranking in the top sixty percent of their class, as well as a conduct score of eighty or higher may apply for scholarships and financial aids. Students who enrolled in Master's or doctoral degree programs and have earned an average score of seventy-five or higher in courses and a conduct score of eighty or higher during the previous academic year may apply for scholarships and financial aids.
